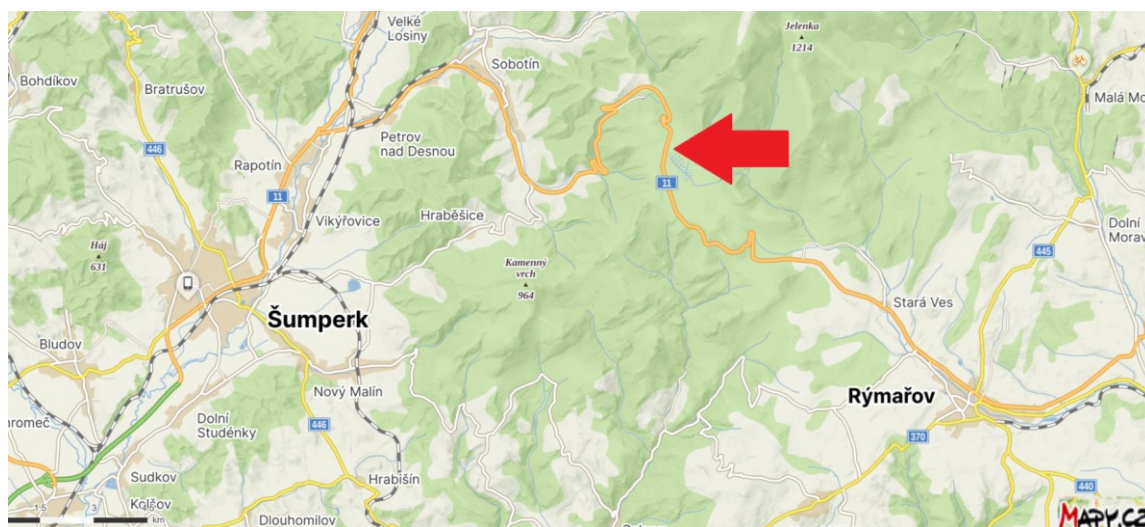

Classes and Participation Restrictions

M21E, W21E

There are no age restrictions. The event is open for all competitors. Women may compete in men's classes.

There is nothing unusual to be expected in the event.

Competitors participate at their own risk. Accident insurance is the responsibility of the participant's Federation or of the competitor him/herself, according to national regulations.

Dimensions of the control description

220 x 70 mm, self-service collection in the 2nd corridor (incl. tape, highlighters, scissors). Control descriptions are also printed on the map.

Compulsory routes: start – map start end last control – finish will be marked with white corridors

Maximum running time: 90 min

Results will be displayed in the arena and will be available online on [OResults](#). Official results will be published in the ORIS system and in the IOF Eventor.

Prize giving ceremony will take place after the competition at approximately 17:00. The top three competitors will receive prizes.

Complaints According to Rules for IOF World Ranking Events. Complaints can be made in the event office no later than 15 minutes after the final results are published. Complaints and protests are free of charge.

Regulation: Participants compete at their own risk. Competitions are held in accordance with the current Competition Rules for IOF Foot Orienteering Events.

Toilets, washing up: Mobile toilets and a mobile water trough will be available at the event center. There will be no toilets on the way to the start.

Food: In the event center there will be a restaurant (hot meals) and refreshment stands (hot dog, beer, lemonade) - you cannot pay by card at the stand, your own drinking cups are welcome; there will also be an opportunity to buy coffee and something sweet at the organizers stand.

Training: There will be training map available at the event center and training area 100 m from the event center. No other training opportunities will be provided by the organizer. Visit the Czech map archive to find suitable terrain for your individual training and contact map owner.

Personal data protection: By registering for this race, each participant agrees to the publication of their personal data in the valid format of the Czech Orienteering Federation (ČSOS), including the application, start list, and results in the ORIS system, Eventor and on the race website. Participants running with a GPS unit also consent to the recording and publication of their route.

Photography: Throughout the event, journalistic photos will be taken for the purpose of informing the public about the competition, settling subsidies for the event, etc., in accordance with §89 of Act No. 89/2012 Coll., the Civil Code. Additionally, photos for the personal needs of the participants may be taken (as a memory of the competition, for the promotion of your o-club), especially during the award ceremony and the finish at the finish line. In case you do not agree with being photographed, please explicitly notify the photographer.

Terrain:

Beautiful but demanding mountain forest at an altitude of 600 - 1,000m with small swamps, rocks and stones, challenging mountain forest floor.

Starting numbers will be available for self-service collection before the start near the posted start lists.

Special symbols: green circle – prominent tree, black cross – man made feature, brown triangle – platform

Climate & Hazards:

Average temperature: 20 °C

Typical maximum daytime temperature: 22 °C

Probability of rain: moderate

There is no special clothing required. Shoes with studs are recommended.

Please be aware of the following natural hazards which can appear during the race: ticks and wasps.

SPORTident - controls will be in contactless mode (AIR+).

Competitor must punch control at the finish line (in contactless mode).

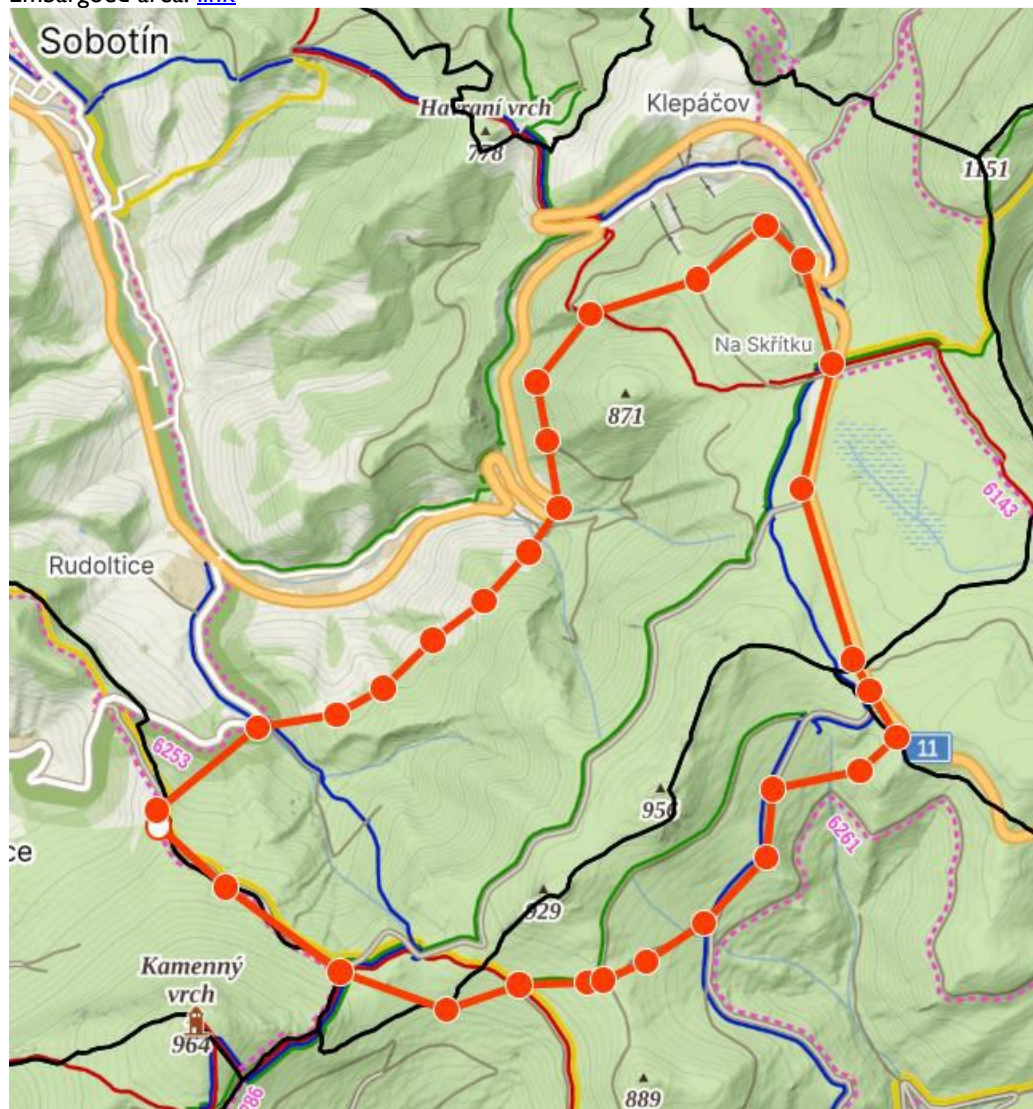
Visas

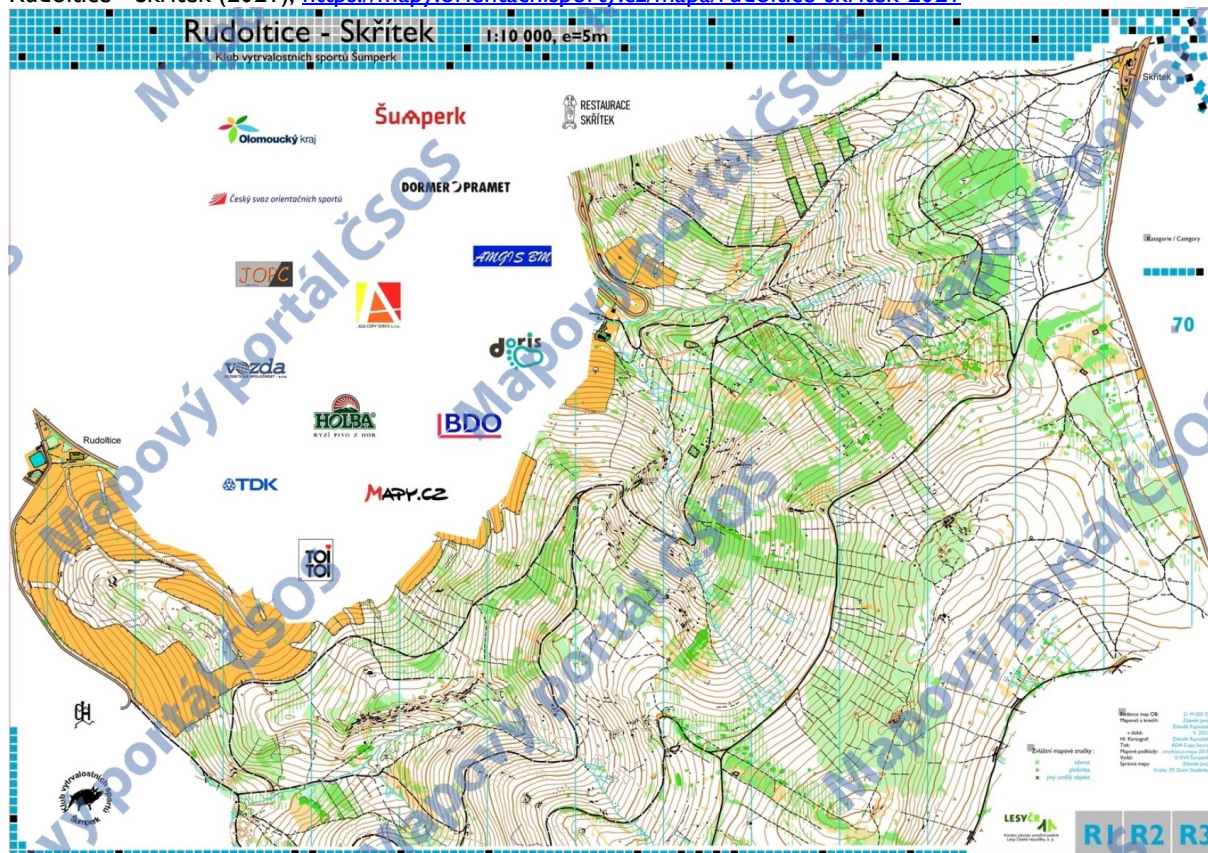

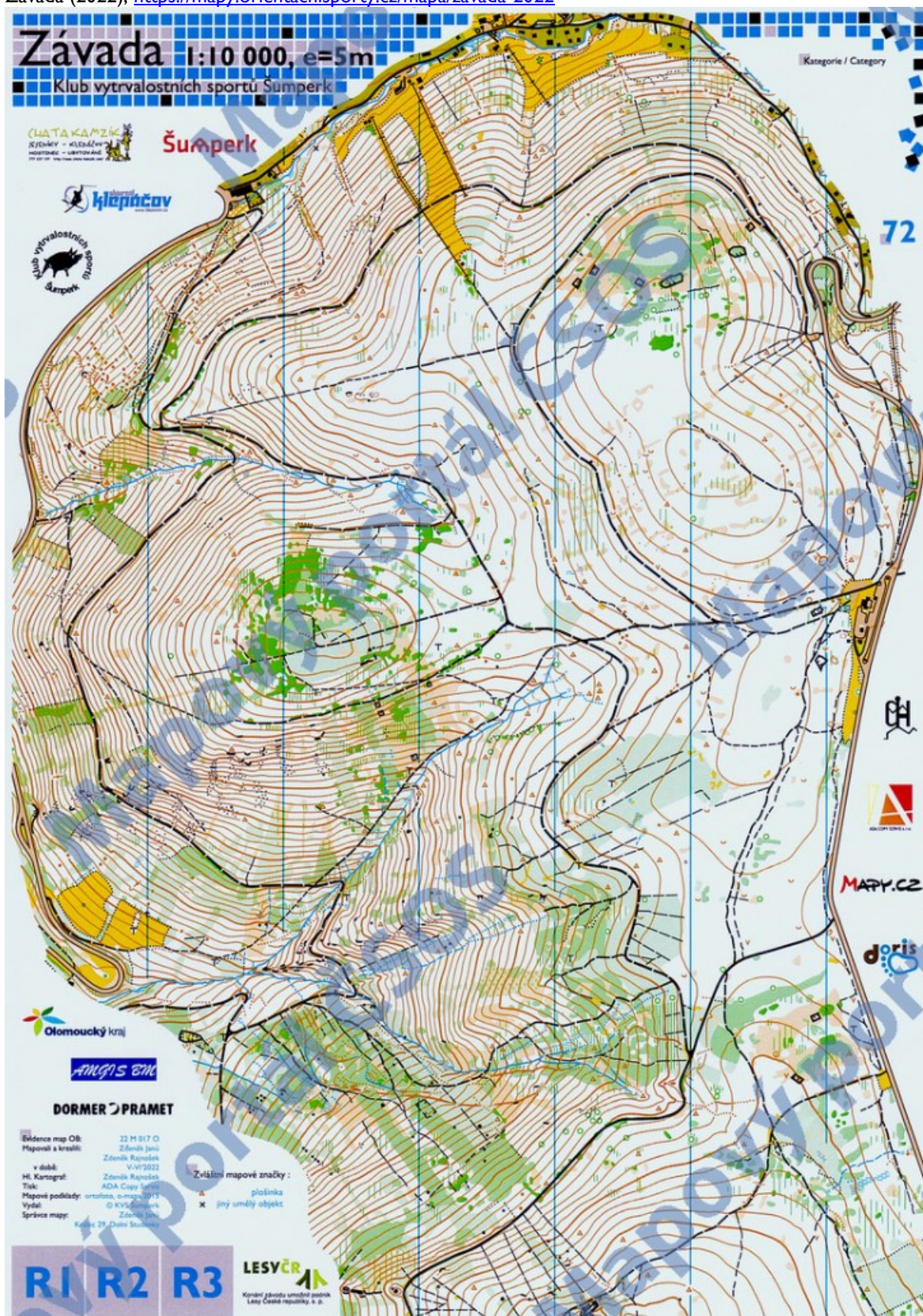
Sample of Old Map
